

**ARLINGTON CEMETERY BOARD
MEETING MINUTES - JUNE 30TH, 2010

OLD BUSINESS: TREES PLANTED BY REDWOOD FALLS NURSERY

Comments: Nice trees

Supt. Thomes will water every 10 days

City Staff will enlarge perimeter of mulch base

Project looks good

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Cemetery yearly report to City Council July 5, 2010.
2. Committee would like to see the road go through the southern section as access to graves difficult in spring and fall.
3. Have road project put into Capital Improvement Plan.
4. Possible seal coating of roads next year.
5. Columbarium is in the Capital Improvement Plan but not in the Budget for 2011.
6. Lawn mowing at cemetery looks good!
7. Order next cemetery mower through cemetery account (will save sales tax, as cemetery purchases are not taxable).
8. Question was raised by Supt. Thomes about removing shrubs on east side of cemetery (request made by Denny Kittock). Several of the shrubs were dying so he would like 12' removed. (Tabled until Committee members can go to cemetery and made an evaluation – vote next meeting.)
9. Motion by **Glieden**, seconded by **Burdorf**, to remove the flag in the cemetery not belonging to the City and ownership seems unknown. (Before removal Councilmember Vrklan recommended Wieman contact Blackie Schwirtz to make sure it doesn't belong to the VFW.)
