MMPA encourages you to conserve energy at home. By participating in our We Save program, you can keep costs down and earn rebates when you purchase an Energy Star qualified central air conditioner.

What rebate can I earn?
 Central Air Conditioner = **\$350**

What does it mean to be Energy Star Qualified?
Central Air Conditioner

- Can cut cooling costs by **30%** (when replacing 12 year old units)
- Is about **14% more** efficient than standard models because they have a higher seasonal efficiency rating (SEER) than standard models

What Product Types Qualify?

New Energy Star Tier 2 requirements for central air conditioners take effect **January 1, 2009**. The new requirements are as follows:

Product Type	SEER	EER
Split System	≥14.5	≥12
Single Package	≥14	≥11

How Do I Qualify?

- Residential customers receiving electric service from a local municipal electric utility that is a participating member of MMPA are eligible for rebates when buying ENERGY STAR qualified central air conditioners.
- Central air conditioner must be ENERGY STAR qualified and labeled accordingly to be eligible for rebates.
- **At time of purchase, central air conditioner must be on current ENERGY STAR list. (Ask your dealer which models are currently listed.)**
- The program is applicable only for the purchase of new ENERGY STAR qualified central air conditioners sold by participating dealers for installation in new or retrofit applications where the electricity is supplied to the participating local municipal electric utilities by MMPA.
- The customer must purchase both the condensing unit and the coil to be eligible for rebate and will not receive rebate if purchasing only a condensing unit without replacing the coil.
- Customer must apply for rebate within one year of the purchase date shown on the sales receipt.
- Rebate applications must include complete dealer and appliance information and include: a copy of dated sales receipt/invoice including manufacturer, model number serial number, SEER rating. Failure to complete the rebate application will result in rejection of the rebate request.
- Rebates are limited to one rebate per customer account per year.
- Rebate requests are processed on a "first-come first-serve" basis. Annual rebate funds are limited. Rebate programs, qualifications, and amounts are subject to change at any time. The customer is responsible for checking with your local municipal electric utility to determine whether the program is still in effect.
