

ARLINGTON CEMETERY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES APRIL 30, 2008

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Pinske at 8:31 A.M.

Members present were Councilman Borchert, Gildea, Glieden, Goblirsch, Pinske, Weckwerth, Wentzlauff and Wiemann. Mayor Jim Kreft and Supt. Dan Thomes also attended.

Minutes of the March meeting were approved as presented.

OLD BUSINESS

Roadway Curve. Supt. Thomes received an estimate of \$1,250 for this project. This project will be added to the specifications of the proposed new roadway project.

Original Cemetery Entrance. There was much discussion of this topic. Mayor Kreft suggested the possibility of locating the original gate at a new location. Concensus of members recommended the gate remain at the present location and be reconstructed to its original design. Greg Goblirsch was instructed to provide Supt. Thomes a photograph of the original gate and name, address of a metalist, Brian Leo, who could advise Supt. Thomes on an estimate to reconstruct the gate.

New Member. The names of Pat Liebl and Elmer Burdorf were given to Mayor Kreft who will consider appointing one of these individuals to fill a vancancy on the Committee.

Perpetual Care. Chairperson Pinske informed the members that the 2007 interest earned by the Fund was \$3,306.60. 60% of proceeds from the sale of burial lots is allocated to the Fund. 12 to 14 burial lots are sold annually.

NEW BUSINESS

Proposed Roadway. Mayor Kreft stated there were no new bids for street construction. The new roadway would be included in these bids. It is possible that the new roadway will be completed in 2008.


Lawn Mower. A new lawn mower has been purchased for use at the cemetery. Supt. Thomes did not know the amount of money assessed to the cemetery budget.

Grave Site Soil Removal. Supt. Thomes stated the soil pile has been removed to a location near the city maintenance building.

Next regular meeting May 28th at 8:30 A. M. at the cemetery.
