

## ARLINGTON CEMETERY COMMITTEE

### Meeting minutes

July 30, 2008

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Pinske at the Community Center Council Chambers at 8:32 A. M.

Members present: Councilman Borchert, Burdorf, Gildea, Goblirsch, Glieden, Pinske, Weckwerth, Wiemann and LaVonne Frauendienst.

Minutes of the June 25, 2008 were approved after being corrected. The correction deleted the last sentence under the topic "Headstones".

### OLD BUSINESS

Update on Community Service Project. Committee pleased with the work done by the Arlington Conquerors 4-H Club. Moved and seconded to have Secretary send a thank you to the Club for their work. Committee suggested that the cemetery lawn mowing crew clean up the weeds and stumps where 4-H Club members removed brush and continue to mow the high grass on North and East cemetery boundaries.

Landscaping. A lengthy discussion on landscaping the boulevard at the new entrance was held. Redwood Falls Nursery's bid of \$1646.42 was the main focus of discussion. Members moved to the cemetery to view the boulevard and discuss in more detail Redwood Falls Nursery proposal. Committee consensus was to accept the bid. Chairperson Pinske, Weckwerth and Frauendienst will select the plantings.

John Schauer's bid of \$850.00 to install cement pavers around the flag pole base to the flood light was also approved. The Veteran Memorial stone will be placed on the pavers.

After viewing the ash trees on the North boundary, a decision was made to have the City Forester view the area and make a recommendation as to the type of planting(s) to use to screen the electric transformers storage area.

### NEW BUSINESS

Review Quarterly Report. The Report showed that two burial lots and two burials were made. Chairperson Pinske stated that two burial lots near the Original Entrance were recently purchased which are not shown on the Report.


2009 Capital Outlay Budget request is \$8,000.00.

LaVonne Frauendienst was appointed to the Committee to fill a vancy.
