

ARLINGTON CEMETERY COMMITTEE

Meeting Minutes

November 26, 2008

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Pinske at the Community Center Council Chambers at 8:30 A. M.

Members present: Burdorf, Gildea, Glieden, Goblirsch, Pinske, Weckwerth and Wiemann. City Administrator Matt Jaunich also attended.

Members absent: Councilman Borchert and Frauendienst.

Minutes of the September 24, 2008 meeting were approved as presented.

OLD BUSINESS

Updates. Brush, trees, limbs, weeds and stumps have been removed from the property on the north and east sides. Shrubbery trimmed on east boundary. Some transformers have been removed from City property on north side of cemetery property. Member Gildea noted that Ordinance #197 states that "No marker or monument shall be placed over a grave except by city permit, and then only when the foundation is carried to the top of the concrete vault and sufficiently enlarged and properly bridged over the casket to properly support the load". This clarifies the statement made by Goblirsch at a previous meeting. The Veteran Memorial has been relocated next to the white cross at the original entrance.

Boundaries and Adjacent Property Owners are located on the east and north sides and maps were given to members indicating these boundaries.

East and Northeast Corner Graves. City Attorney Ross Arneson states in a memo that no graves are located in the questioned area.


NEW BUSINESS

Committee Applications were given to members to complete and return to the City Office if they wish to be appointed to the committee for 2009 and beyond. The reasoning for the use of the application form, according to Administrator Jaunich, is that more people are moving into the community that may be interested in serving on a city committee.
