It's that time of year . . . Summer Recreation is about to start!!!

The Summer Recreation staff this year will include Director Doug Flieth, Stephanie Schultz, and Paul Pichelmann. Listed below is what will be offered this summer. (Note: Grade designation is the most current grade completed.)

T- BALL – Kindergarten -1st grade. Players have the option of hitting from a tee or receiving pitches from the instructor. Basic fundamentals are taught, including base running, fielding, catching, and throwing. T-Ball is held on mornings that there aren't games for the older kids, from 11:00 – 12:00 at the Four Seasons Park. Schedules will be handed out at first day of practice, June 9th.

POPPERS – 2nd and 3rd grades. Players will be divided into two teams and will be pitched to by the instructor. Fundamentals will continue to be worked on daily. Poppers will be held on mornings that there aren't games for the older kids, from 11:00 – 12:00 at the Four Seasons Park. Schedules will be handed out at first day of practice, June 9th.

The following programs are included in the traveling schedule. The Central Six League includes baseball and softball teams from Arlington, Glencoe, Brownston, G-F-W, and Gaylord. We play each team at home and on the road. Games are held Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays with practices held on mornings that there are not games. Practices will start June 9th.

JR. MIDGET SOFTBALL – Girls in grades 4-6. Participants play the game of fast-pitch softball, without bunting and stealing. Practice is held behind the high school from 8:00-9:30.

MIDGET SOFTBALL – Girls in grades 7-9. Participants play by Minnesota State High School League rules. Practice is held behind the high school from 9:30-11:00.

PEANUT BASEBALL – Boys in grades 4-5. Participants play with bunting, no leading off, and stealing. Practice is held at Four Seasons Park from 8:00-9:30.

PEE WEE BASEBALL – Boys in grades 6-7. Participants play with bunting, leading off, and stealing. Practice is held at the Arlington A's Baseball Field from 8:00-9:30.

MIDGET BASEBALL – Boys in 8-9. Participants follow Minnesota State High School League rules. Practice is held at the A's park from 9:30-11:00.
