Mayor Nagel stated the purpose of the workshop was to discuss a Strategic Planning Process with Hamblin Professor Craig Waldron.

Prof. Waldron introduced himself and summarized his resume/background.

Prof. Waldron explained how the planning session works and how he likes to handle them. His students would be involved/observe the process. Some Council Members expressed concern about gathering public input as part of the process. Waldron feels a smaller group of people is easier to work with and he recommended designating representatives/leaders from the community and organizations. Overall the Council was receptive/excited about the process. Adm. Donabauer stated that this will be a guiding document/plan that will assist with budget development and governmental or city-wide decisions. Prof. Waldron recommended holding a strategic session once every 3-5 years unless there was significant turn over within the City; and set a limited (reasonable) number of goals.
