SPECIAL ARLINGTON CITY COUNCIL & JOINT EDA COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES MARCH 16, 2016

The Special Council Meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m., Mayor Nagel presiding.

The Special EDA Meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m., President Thomes presiding.

President Thomes stated that the purpose of the meeting was to meet jointly with the Council to discuss a purchase offer for the EDA owned property at 105 4th Avenue NW.

President Thomes recessed the special joint meeting to hold a closed joint meeting.

Prahl presented the information pertaining to the (cash) offer for the EDA property located at 105 4th Avenue NW. It was noted that the property had been listed for sale at \$45,000. Prahl provided a brief background on the buyers and what their plans were for the building (it would be used for retail purposes). She stated that upon the offer being accepted, the buyers were eager to get into the property and would like to see a closing date in early April. Prahl commented that she had not taken any other offers on the property, but three or four groups had viewed the property; all expressed concern about the condition of the roof.

President Thomes adjourned the closed portion of the meeting and reconvened the special joint meeting.

Motion by Sorenson, seconded by Kloeckl, and passed by unanimous vote to accept the offer on the EDA property located at 105 4th Avenue NW.

It was noted that if improvements were needed on the roof, the work to be done would qualify under one of the EDA loan/grant programs.

The Council reviewed the EDA's recommendation to accept the offer for the EDA property located at $105 4^{th}$ Avenue NW. Heiland felt the offer was too low.

Motion Jaszewski, seconded by Battcher, and carried (Heiland opposed) to approve the EDA's recommendation to accept the offer for the EDA property located at 105 4th Avenue NW.

President Thomes adjourned the EDA portion of the special joint meeting.

Motion by Battcher seconded by Nuesse, and passed by unanimous vote to adjourn the Council portion of the special joint meeting at 5:46 pm.
