

ORDINANCE 256

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5, SUBDIVISION 2(6)(C) AND SECTION 6, SUBDIVISION 2(5)(C) OF ORDINANCE NO. 169 THE ZONING ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE KEEPING OF PETS AS ACCESSORY USES IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS.

I. THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ARLINGTON, MINNESOTA TO PROMOTE THE PUBLIC SAFETY, HEALTH, AND WELFARE, HEREBY ORDAINS:

A. SECTION 5, SUBDIVISION 2(6)(C) OF ORDINANCE NO. 169 THE ZONING ORDINANCE SHALL BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

C. ~~Maintenance of dogs or cats or other household pets not to exceed two (2) full grown animals of each type. A full grown animal is defined as an animal of breeding age.~~ **Reserved.**

B. SECTION 6, SUBDIVISION 2(5)(C) OF ORDINANCE NO. 169 THE ZONING ORDINANCE SHALL BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

C. ~~Maintenance of dogs or cats or other household pets not to exceed two (2) full grown animals of each type. A full grown animal is defined as an animal of breeding age.~~ **Reserved.**

II. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance is effective upon its adoption and publication as prescribed by law.
