The following individuals met for the meeting: Al Ihrke, Karan Pichelmann, Jerry Ebersviller, Walt Allison, Maintenance Supervisor Kirby Weckworth, Councilmember Ben Jaszewski. Mayor Rich Nagel also attended. Unable to attend: Bob Thomes and Gary Hultgren.

1. Meeting was called to order by Chairperson Ihrke at 7:04 P.M.
2. Approve Agenda: Pichelmann made a motion to approve the agenda, Ebersviller seconded the motion, approved by all.
3. Approve Minutes of June 26, 2017: Pichelmann read the minutes of June 26<sup>th</sup>, 2017, but there was an error, should read “Approve Minutes of May 22<sup>nd</sup>”, Ebersviller made a motion to approve the minutes with the correction, Allison seconded the motion, approved by all.
4. New Business:
  - A. Drinking fountain @ Sportsman’s Park: Weckworth was approached by a parent to see if a drinking fountain could be installed closer to the field. The cost could range between \$1200 - \$1500 to put a line in per Geib Well Co/Duane Geib. Everyone thought that this was a good idea but will put this item off until spring that this could be added to the budget. There was a line years back, need to find out if the line is working. Kirby will check on this issue also.
  - B. Backdrop for Dan “Buck” Thomes Sign @ Sportman’s Park: Ebersviller will check into this issue to see what can be done and will get a hold of Jim Pederson to see if he has something that will work.
5. Other/Update: Gazebo bids will go out in either February or March of 2018. Weckworth addressed the issue of a storage shed at the Sportsman’s Park so that bases/rakes and the portable pitching mound could be stored in. Not sure what the budget reflects; have to see if this can be done. Will hold off till spring to see how much a shed would cost and where it could be placed – hopefully would like closer to the field. At the present time, will store items in the enclosed shelter bldg.

7. Adjournment: Ebersviller made a motion to adjourn, Jaszewski seconded the motion, approved by all. Meeting was adjourned at 7:35 P.M.
