# ARLINGTON CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES SEPTEMBER 28, 2018

The Special Council Meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m., Mayor Nagel presiding.

Members Present: Mayor Rich Nagel, Michelle Battcher, Ben Jaszewski, Jim Heiland.

Members Absent: Tom Hatlestad, Adam Cowell Also Present: City Adm. Pat Melvin, Kurt Menk

Motion by Battcher, seconded by Heiland, and passed by unanimous vote to approve the agenda as presented.

Mayor Nagel stated the purpose of the meeting was to finalize the 2019 Preliminary Tax Levy.

Adm. Melvin stated that he was presenting a resolution to rescind the resolution approved at a previous meeting adopting the 2019 Preliminary Tax Levy. In said previous levy, he had some bond payments listed, but did not include the assessments that go with said bond payments. The City's Auditor has since reviewed the proposed levy and suggested a 10% increase. Adm. Melvin had a chance to review the minimum requirement for the reserve fund and found that the City needs to have 5-6 months of expenditures in that account. The City has over one million dollars in the reserves account currently (this does fluctuate). City Adm. Melvin commented that a CD in the amount of approximately a quarter of a million dollars just matured and was put into a money market account and earning interest. It was available if the Council decided to use it for one of the larger projects. He added that the City has over four million dollars in investments.

Councilmember Battcher introduced the following resolution and moved for its adoption:

WHEREAS, Resolution 60-2018, Setting the Preliminary 2019 Tax Levy, as approved on Tuesday, September 25,2018 contained inaccuracies in bond amounts payable in 2019 through the City levy;

WHEREAS, the taxpayers of the City of Arlington will be notified of the impact of the preliminary tax levy on their truth in taxation statements sent out in November and will be provided an opportunity to provide input regarding the proposed net tax levy and budget at the public hearing December 3<sup>rd</sup> at 6:00 p.m. held in the Council Chambers at the Arlington Community Center.
