

**RESOLUTION 63-2020**

**A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE EXPENDITURE AND USE OF  
CORONAVIRUS AID RELIEF AND ECONOMIC SECURITY (CARES) ACT  
FUNDING**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Arlington has received \$168,009 in Coronavirus Aid Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act funding from the Federal Government; and

**WHEREAS**, Federal and State guidelines have indicated uses of the funding to support cities in the challenges brought about by the COVID-19 health pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, the Arlington City Council has worked diligently to meet the guidelines and approve spending only on authorized expenses according to the CARES Act; and

**WHEREAS**, Federal guidance has restricted the use of CARES Act funds to include but not limited to: 1) administrative costs to administer CARES funds; 2) budgeted personnel and services diverted to a substantially different use; 3) COVID-19 testing and contact tracing; 4) improving the tele networking capabilities of public employees; 5) payroll for public health and safety employees; 6) personal protective equipment; 7) public health expenses; 8) small business assistance; and

**WHEREAS**, eligible expenses must be accrued between March 1, 2020 and November 15, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Arlington did not use the funds for revenue reimbursement for any losses during COVID-19 related to shutdowns, expenses accounted for in the 2020 budget, or expenses reimbursed from other COVID-19 Federal assistance programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Arlington completed all monthly reporting requirements with the State of Minnesota, and as of November 12, 2020 all funds have been spent per state and federal guidelines.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Arlington City Council hereby utilized their CARES Act funding for the following items:

- \$2,697.76 for Administrative Expenses
- \$175.00 for COVID-19 Testing and Contact Tracing
- \$129,838.63 for Payroll for Public Health and Safety Employees
- \$1481.52 for Personal Protective Equipment

- \$33,815.09 for Small Business Assistance

**BE IT FURTHER RESOVLED**, that the City of Arlington had additional COVID-19 related costs that CARES Funds could be utilized for and has kept appropriate records of those expenses.
