Reminder on Sidewalk Snow Removal

Property owners should remember that City Ordinance requires that all ice and snow must be removed form public sidewalks within 12 hours after such snow or ice has ceased to be deposited. Failure to remove the snow or ice within 24 hours may be a cause for City staff to remove it. If City staff has to remove it, the property owner will be billed accordingly. Unpaid bills for snow removal will be a cause for a special assessment against the property. Also, please remember to clear snow away from fire hydrants so they are visible to firefighters.

City Council Considering Goals

City Council members discussed setting goals at their regular City Council meeting on January 18th. Some of those goals included: electronic records for the Arlington Public Cemetery, continue with a 10-year Capital Improvement Plan, to simplify and correct City Codes, to update the City's Comprehensive Plan, and finally to direct EDA to look at low income housing options for the City. City Council will finalize their 2022 goals at the next meeting.
