Choose Arlington

The Choose Arlington organization, in partnership with the City of Arlington, implemented a Welcome Bag program last fall for new residents. The project has been very successful as numerous Welcome Bags have been handed out.

Local businesses, organizations and churches are still encouraged to contribute marketing items for these Welcome Bags. The items could include gift certificates, coupons, trinkets and marketing materials. Items must be smaller than 8 X 10 inches. No more than 25 items are suggested for starters.

People can drop off their items at the Arlington City Office between 8:30 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.

In the past two years, Choose Arlington has conducted a community survey, received a \$20,000 grant from the Southern Minnesota Initiative Foundation, made a \$300 donation to the Arlington Area Ambulance Service, and has implemented an active Facebook page.

Before you dig contact Gopher State One Call at 811, 651-454-0002, toll free at 1-800-252-1166 or visit Call811.com. Call at least 2 working days before digging in your yard. Gopher State One Call will contact all utilities to mark underground lines for free. Be aware that "private" lines exist on many properties, and these are the owner's responsibility to know their location.



Reminder to mow lawns

City Code 6.9 states that lawns and landscaped areas are to be cut or trimmed so the **grass does not exceed 6 inches** in height. Residents wishing to file a complaint about high grass should contact Planning and Zoning at 507-964-2378 ext. 3.
