Adopt a Catch Basin

If you have a storm catch basin near your house, it is a wonderful civic help to yourself and your neighbors, if you can help keep them unplugged during rainy days and the upcoming leaf fall. Simply use a rake, shovel, or hands to open up the top of the catch basin if plugged with leaves.
