Adopt a Catch Basin

If you have a storm catch basin near your house, it is a wonderful civic help to yourself and your neighbors, if you can help keep them unplugged during rainy days and the upcoming leaf fall. The City staff will be doing its best to keep the streets and catches clean, but cannot be everywhere at once, nor working after hours. Simply use a rake, shovel, or hands to open up the top of the catch basin if plugged with leaves. The sweeping of streets becomes a priority in the fall, but limited staff needs to fulfill other duties at times. Please be patient as fall cleanup ensues, typically until snowfall begins, and enjoy the season!

Welcome Bags

The EDA is bringing back the Welcome Bags! The City is currently accepting items to be placed in the welcome bags for new residents moving into the city. Please drop items off at the City Office for placement in the bags. Items can include business cards, pens or other items promoting your business!
